Directions from the church:

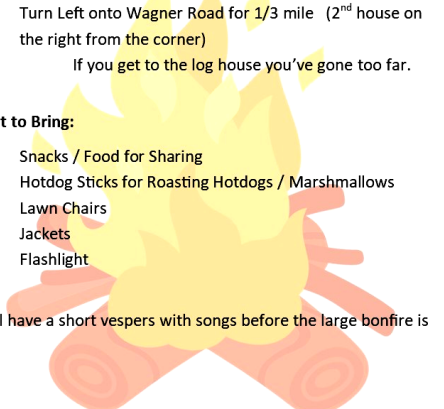
Go West on East Linden Street, drive 2.1 miles
