What are they?

CAES will hold its annual constituency meeting this coming Thursday. Meanwhile, we are electing delegates for the Idaho Conference constituency meeting scheduled for September. It's a good time for a quick review of what this means.

Webster's defines a constituent as *a member of* and *an essential part*.

The Caldwell Church is a constituent church of CAES. Along with the Nampa and Gem State Academy Churches, we provide financial support to <u>our</u> school. Each year, the school holds a meeting to report on the school year, present the budget, and deal with any other matters of business.

As members of this church, each of us is a CAES constituent and a voting member at this meeting. We are each an essential part.

As a church we are also a constituent of the Idaho Conference, along with all SDA churches in southern Idaho and eastern Oregon.
