

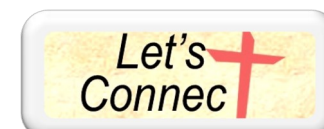

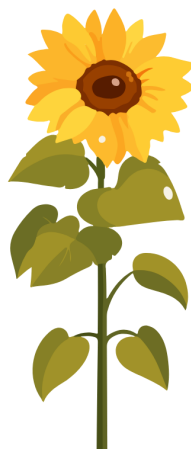

Also needed— new volunteers to work in the clothing room give away, sorting area, and food area weekly on Mondays and Tuesdays, and someone who can help with grant writing.



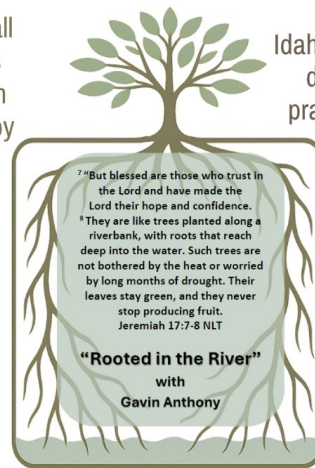
Please continue to keep the Rutherford family in your prayers. A memorial service for Kyle is being planned for the end of September.
